Intake process: Walk-in. Application required. Only one application per family per child will be accepted. Documents: Parents must provide photo ID (drivers license, state ID, passport, green card), as well as the child's original birth certificate or medical card with birth date. Proof of Columbus residency (gas, electric, water or phone bill in parents' name). If guardian is not listed on birth certificate, court documents verifying guardianship must be shown.

  - Current Lease Agreement (No handwritten leases accepted) **OR**
  - Current Gas Bill in your name with correct address listed **OR**
  - Current Electric Bill in your name with correct address listed

**Children in Household:** (DOB must be included on each document provided)

- **Original Health Card** with Child's Name **and** Date of Birth (copies will not be accepted) **OR**
- **Original Birth Certificate** with Child's Name **and** Date of Birth (copies will not be accepted)
  - Original Birth Records will only be accepted for children under 3 months old **OR**
- **School/Health Record** with Child's Name **and** Date of Birth
- **Guardians must bring legal documents establishing custody**
- **Toy registration is for children 12 and younger**
