INTRODUCING A NEW, USER-FRIENDLY BILL ASSISTANCE TOOL

A new electric **bill assistance tool** from AEP Ohio helps educate customers about financial and energy-efficiency assistance programs offered by AEP and the state of Ohio. Customers can quickly determine which programs they qualify for by answering a brief, six-question online questionnaire.

HOW IT HELPS CUSTOMERS

After completing the survey, you'll receive a list of programs recommended for your specific situation, in order of the level of assistance they can provide, and details needed to apply.* All responses are confidential and will only be used to recommend your electric bill assistance options.

There are a variety of programs, including:

- Direct bill credit to pay down your past due balance.
- Home weatherization upgrades to help reduce your electric usage and improve your comfort.
- Reduced payment programs to make your electric bill more manageable.

*Some programs included may be administered through federal or state agencies. Customers must work directly with the agency administering the program to confirm eligibility and complete an application or other process. Completing an application does not guarantee the applicant's household will receive assistance.
