Bring unwanted, unneeded or expired prescription and over-the-counter pills to Columbus Public Health. Law enforcement officers will safely dispose of your medicine.

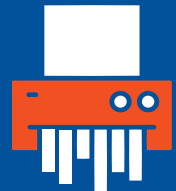
No liquids, gel caps, aerosols, inhalers or thermometers please.
