
## What saves the most ELECTRICITY?

Unplug that second refrigerator or freezer.

SAVE


\$252 or 1,800 Kilowatt-Hours–Per Year



Reduce your need for electric space heaters. Weatherize your house and wear winter clothing.

SAVE

or 620 Kilowatt-Hours—Per Heater—Per Year



**Switch from Air Conditioning to** fans to stay cool. Exhaust hot air when it's cooler outside.

SAVE

or 350 Kilowatt-Hours—Per Family of 3—Per Year




Electric usage adds up so turn off unused TVs, lights and appliances.

or 267 Kilowatt-Hours—Per Family of 3—Per Year

## What saves the most GAS?


Gas is sold in CCFs or Hundred Cubic Feet



Install clock thermostat with a 5 degree setback at night.


SAVE

\$138 or 91 CCFs—Per Household—Per Year



Seal up big holes on the top floor and in the basement.


\$108 or 71 CCFs—Per Household—Per year



Caulk and rope caulk windows. Close storms or install plastic window kits.

SAVE

\$90 or 59 CCFs—Per Household—Per year




**Lower your water temperature to** warm or normal and wrap your hot water heater.

SAVE

\$46 or 30 CCFs—Per Household—Per year

## What saves the most WATER?


Water is sold in CCFs or Hundred Cubic Feet. One CF= about 8 gallons.



Repair running toilet, and big leaks in pipes and faucet.

SAVE


\$640 or 150,000 Gallons—Per Active Leak—Per Year



Repair dripping faucet and pipe leaks.

SAVE

\$130 or 30,000 Gallons—Per Active Leak—Per Year



Take short showers or half baths.

SAVE

\$80 or 18,000 Gallons—Per Family of 3—Per Year



**Shut** water off when washing dishes, brushing teeth or shaving.

SAVE

\$28 or 6,000 Gallons—Per Family of 3—Per Year
