EarlyLearn NYC provides full-time childcare to low-income families with children from birth to 2 years old. Extended day/year programs provide early care and education services for up to 10 hours a day.

Eligibility

Enrollment for extended and not extended programs

- Admissions for infant and toddler programs are year-round. Your child can enroll in a program any time, if you are eligible
 and there is a seat available.

- Contact individual programs to determine requirements for enrollment.
