### Spring of 7<sup>th</sup> grade

### Fall of 8<sup>th</sup> grade

- Submit online application. You may choose up to 5 schools.
- Complete other requirements – essays, interviews, auditions.
- Attend the high school fair in October.
- Visit high schools – open houses, shadow days, interviews.
