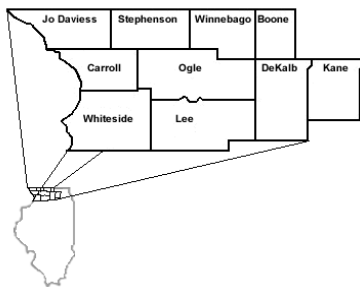


# Autism Resource Library
